History:

In 2004, the North Dakota Community Action Association (NDCAA) began a public education campaign to encourage local community sporting groups to develop a venison donation program. This campaign was initiated due to the statewide problem of hunger.

The campaigns main focus is to educate hunting groups, smaller local hunting organizations and meat processors about the Sportsmen Against Hunger Program encouraging them to develop fundraisers to support the program.

In 2004, 115 deer were processed and distributed to needy families, in 2005, 241 deer were processed and distributed.

2006 Results:

Due to the generosity of sportsmen, sportsmen's clubs, and the processors, **Sportsman Against Hunger processed 369 deer in 2006.** Venison was distributed by volunteers, club members and Community Action agencies to numerous food pantries and other emergency food outlets across the state.

Future:

Many organizations are getting involved in the program and making a difference in their communities. Through continued support this program will expand and continue to assist emergency food outlets throughout the state and help make a difference in lives of hungry North Dakota families.
