Rental Assistance



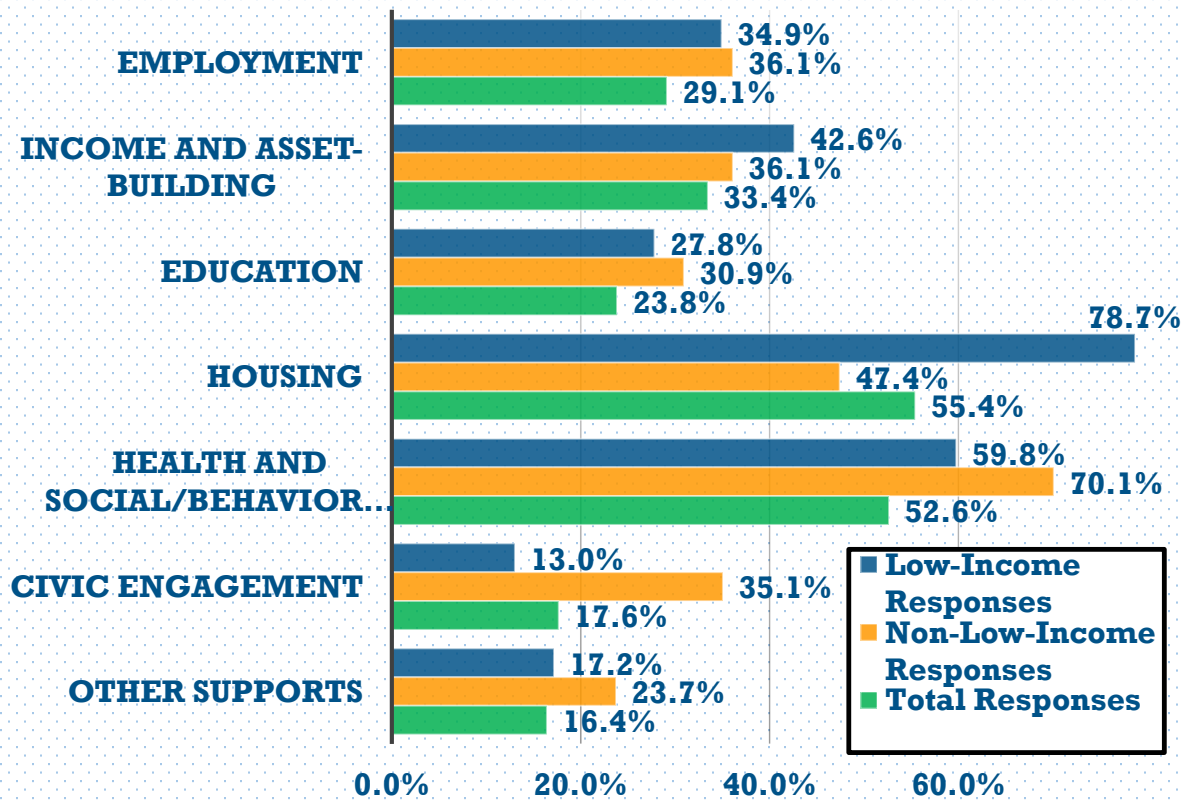

“*Rental Assistance*” is the 1st priority need of people experiencing poverty under the category of “*Housing*” in CAA Region 8.

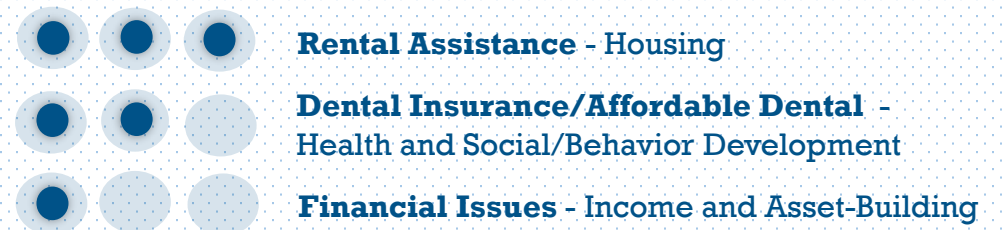
The 1st priority need for the non-low-income respondents is “*Mental Health Service*”.

Overall Community (Low-Income & Non-Low-Income)

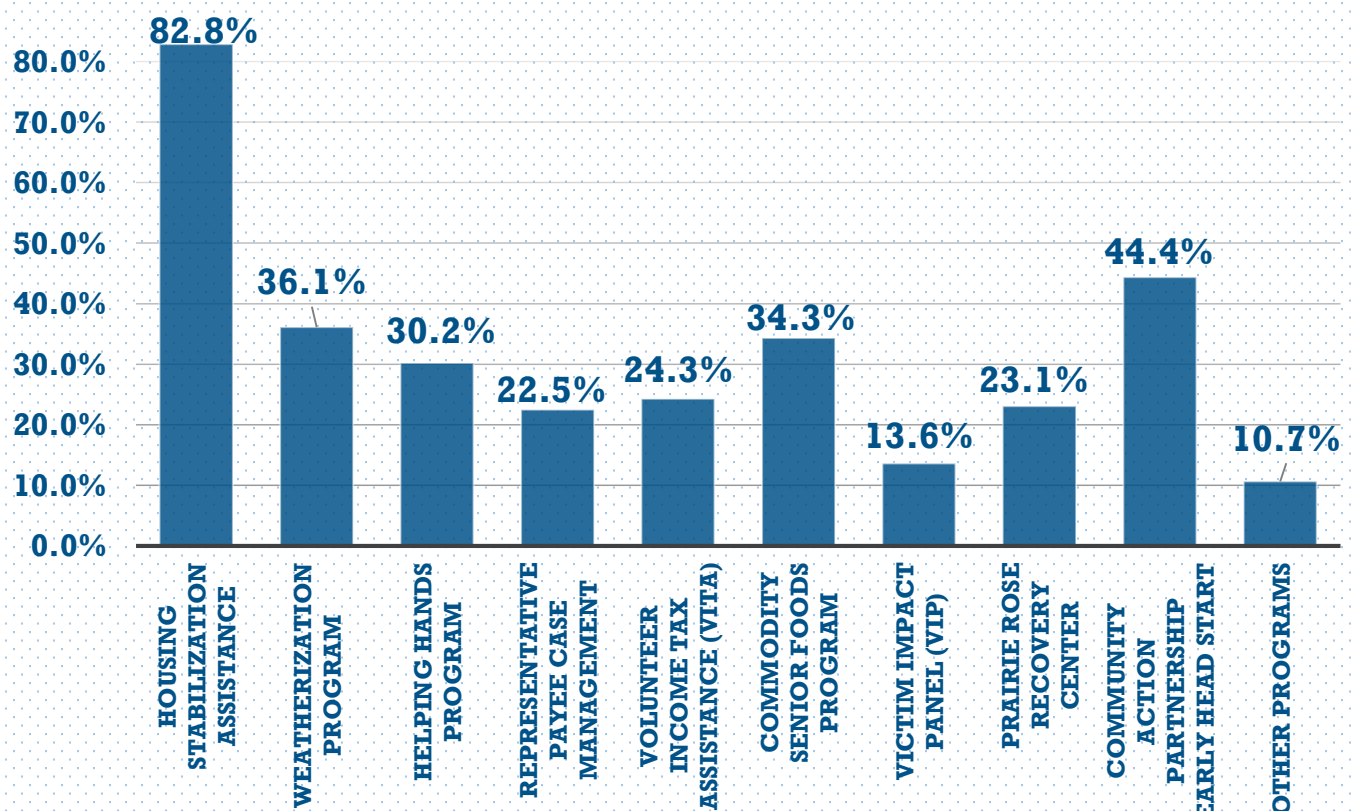


REGION 8 LOCAL PROGRAMS FOR LOW INCOMES

3. Weatherization Program (36.1%)

6. Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) (24.3%)
7. Prairie Rose Recovery Center (23.1%)
8. Representative Payee Case Management (22.5%)
9. Victim Impact Panel (VIP) (13.6%)
